### ADVANCED COMPENSATION PAYMENTS

Advance compensation payments may be authorized covering a period of no longer than two weeks, where the worker has not filed a claim for compensation but where there is sufficient evidence of disability and the employer's report of accident meets the following criteria:

- (a) the information indicates a clear-cut accident insofar as the claims officer is concerned,
- (b) the Assessment Department is satisfied as to the coverage aspect based on the information indicated by the employer,
- (c) the type of injury that procures a substantial time loss of at least two weeks,
- (d) the claim is straight forward and there are no complications and,
- (e) the employer will not continue to pay the employee during the period of disability.
