



## Policy *Revocation* Proposal

### FA-02 Accounting Policy

In the course of considering proposed amendments to our current policies to align with the new *Workers' Safety and Compensation Act* (the 'Act'), this policy has been identified for revocation.

The new Act comes into force July 1, 2022. The intended effective date of the proposed policy revocation will be July 1, 2022.

This policy states that the board shall follow accounting procedures that are in accordance with the applicable provisions of the *Financial Administration Act* and with the generally accepted accounting principles set out in the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants' Handbook.

Accounting and auditing standards for the preparation of financial statements for public bodies are governed by their respective governing bodies and the rules and standards established therein. It is proposed that there is no need for this policy and it be revoked.

### ACCOUNTING POLICY

#### **PURPOSE**

This policy clarifies the accounting procedures that will be followed by the Yukon Workers' Compensation Health and Safety Board (YWCHSB).
