

BOARD POLICIES

CLAIMS

At the Workers' Compensation Advisory Board meeting of February 15, 1977, the following policy was agreed upon and adopted.

No. 9 In Course of Employment

- (1) In buildings where there are two or more occupants, the worker is considered to be in the course of employment from the point which the worker enters the door of the building or from the foot of the stairs, leading to the building entrance and continues in a direct route to the actual place of employment.
- (2) In multiple tenant areas such as shopping centers, a worker would not be considered to be in the course of employment until the entrance to the actual premises of the employer has been reached (subject to the policy covering parking lot cases).
