BOARD POLICIES

ASSESSMENT

At the Workers' Compensation Board meeting held on March 19, 1987 the following policy was agreed upon and adopted.

No. 15 Assessment of Operators of Taxi-Cabs

All persons operating taxi-cabs in Yukon including owner/operators, drivers employed by them, drivers of leased cabs and notwithstanding the conditions of any contract or agreement between the parties are deemed workers of the party holding the Yukon Motor Vehicle Transport Board's authority and that party is deemed the employer for the purposes of the Act.

In 1987 the Taxi-Cabs Industrial Classification 6, Industry 068, is assessed at a rate of \$1.25 per 100 dollars of payroll.

The rate will be applied to all drivers based on an assumed gross income of \$17,500 per annum and assessment shall be recovered at the rate of \$.85 for each 12 hour shift commenced and \$.57 for each 8 hour shift commenced.

All employees other than drivers will be assessed on gross payroll in the normal manner.

This order does not apply to the Directors of the Incorporation, Proprietor, or Partners, of the business holding the authority.
