ASSESSMENT

At the Workers' Compensation Advisory Board meeting of February 15, 1977 the following policy was agreed upon and adopted:

No. 3 Full or Part-time Employees

An employee working regularly each day is as a general thing considered a regular and not part-time employee; although the employment may not be for the usual full working day. If, however, employment is intermittent and on occasional days only, the employment may be classified as a part-time employee, no set rule can be made and each should be considered on its own merits and according to its own particular circumstances, and each should be referred for a decision.
