BOARD POLICIES

ASSESSMENT

At the Workers' Compensation Advisory Board meeting of February 15, 1977 the following policy was agreed upon and adopted.

No. 2 Employers in More Than One Industry

- (a) Where an employer engages in some operations other than the regular industry, and in doing so employs a separate and distinct group of employees, then in such case, the employer shall be required to furnish a separate and distinct payroll covering such separate employees and shall be assessed in respect of such separate employees at the rate applicable to that particular form of industry.
- (b) Where an employer engages in some operations other than the regular industry but for and in connection therewith, and performs it with the employer's regular employees then it shall be deemed to be part of the regular industry.
